Doggie Race

Competition Rules and Legal Regulations



1. **General.**

- All participants must have fun and enjoy the race.
- It is the pet owner's responsibility to read, understand and obey the Competition Rules and Regulations.
- By formalizing the inscription, the participant accepts the Competition Rules and Legal Regulations, and the terms and conditions of participation.
- Each participant is responsible for competing in appropriate physical health and having had enough training for the distance of the race. The participant is also responsible for his/her pet's physical health, who must also participate under the same conditions.
- The participants must obey the instructions of the events employees, volunteers, vets, and the relevant public authorities.
- It is forbidden to cheat during the race. The participants may not cut off or endanger the other participants. It is also forbidden to obstruct the process of the race. The participants must be respectful amongst themselves, towards the volunteers, and medical and security personnel. Road directions must be followed, as well as instructions from organizers, officials and medical and security personnel. The participants must be respectful towards the natural environment and pick up after their dogs during the whole race.
- The participants, both owners and dogs, must wear a Port Adriano Doggie Race official t-shirt and bandana during the race which will be included in the runner's bag. The runner and the pet will be disqualified by the organization if this rule isn't strictly obeyed.
- All owners are required to have all the up-to-date health documents for their pets, and all pets must be properly chipped. The organization may ask to see this documentation at any time.
- The organization will be randomly checking the pet owners to ensure that the event's safety and security conditions are being met. Accordingly, the event's certified vets may ask to inspect the owner's documentation and/or the corresponding pet's chip.
- Your pet's behavior must be adequate, sociable and respectful to participate in the Doggie Race. If your pet has difficulty interacting with other dogs or even humans, then these kinds of events should be avoided.
- Dog breeds which are included in the Potentially Dangerous Dog Register are allowed to participate as long as they meet all the mandatory security requirements: Corresponding license, Civil responsibility insurance which covers damage to third parties, and the approved lead and muzzle. Even so, they must be constantly watched by their owners.



- Throughout the race the dogs must be on leads at all times.
- Your dog must be at least 7 months old to participate in the Doggie Race.
- To ensure both the pets' and the participants' safety, the Doggie Race organization recommends that the dogs be up-to-date with their vaccines and parasite prevention medication.
- Enrollment in the Doggie Race implies that the participants accept the Competition Rules and Regulations, excluding the Port Adriano Doggie Race organization from all responsibility of any incident that may occur, both to the participant or the pet, and also in the event that a pet may cause any type of incident, harm or damage during its participation in the event.
- The basic principles of the Doggie Race are to ENJOY and OBEY THE RULES. Remember that you are participating in a sporting event which has been organized for your entertainment and so you can enjoy the unique natural surroundings, you must always be respectful towards your fellow competitors, towards the organizations personnel, and help us to look after and respect the environment.

2. Participants.

- Participants must be 18 or over to participate. Anyone under-age can participate with a parent or legal guardian authorization.
- The route of the race may be altered or cancelled due to weather conditions, if the organization's technical and safety committee sees fit to do so.
- There will be provisioning stations strategically placed by the organization throughout the race and at the finish line.
- Enrollments are personal and non-transferable. Enrollments imply that the participant accepts the race's security regulations.
- The inscription fees will not be refunded under any circumstances so long as the race takes place. If the race is cancelled, the organization will reschedule a new date for the race. Refunding inscription fees will only apply in case of permanent cancelation.
- Each participant will receive a bag with information about the race, an identifying t-shirt and bandana, a keep-sake, as well as other material the organization finds pertinent.
- The organization is not responsible for loss of objects and/or personal effects. To avoid this situation, we recommend valuable items not be left in the checkroom.
- Each participant, both owners and pets, must wear the official t-shirt and bandana during the entirety of the race, which will be handed out during the try-outs.
- Leads must be used at all times.



3. **Enrollments.**

- The enrollment fee is 15€ for single inscription (1 Person + 1 Dog) and 18€ for couple inscription (2 Persons + 1 Dog), all the collection will be donated to “Asociación Sin Ánimo de Lucro Peluditos de Son Reus” (Son Reus Fury Charity). These funds will be aimed at improving resources for abandoned dogs who need care and attention, and to help find them new homes.
- In the event that more than one person should want to participate with the same pet, a new inscription shall be filled in for each person.

4. **Race Number and Runner Bag Collection.**

- Participants must collect their race number and bag at Port Adriano the day of the race between 08:30 and 09:45.
- Participants must show their proof of payment, which must be formalized through www.elitechip.net, to be able to collect the race number and bag. If you are unavailable to collect your own number and bag, another person may do it for you, supplying the following documents: proof of payment, a signed authorization and the participants ID card.
- Numbers and bags will not be given out on the day of the race.
- By not collecting the race number and bag on the provided date, the Port Adriano Doggie Race participant will lose his/her right to said bag and number and will not be able to participate in the race.

5. **Insurance.**

The organization will have a civil responsibility insurance policy and an accidents insurance policy, as current legislation reflects, so that all participants are covered.

6. **Personal Details.**

In compliance with the establish Personal Data Protection organic law 15/1999 of the 13th of December, and the information and electronic commerce social services law 43/2002 of the 11th of July, DA Sports Events informs that with your enrollment you are hereby accepting the following:

All personal details provided by yourself through the forms filled in on the www.elitechip.net are incorporated in a personal, automatic file of which DA Sports Events is responsible.

The purpose of this confidential file is:

- Administrating your participation in the event.
- To manage the race information, especially the times, photographs and videos.
- Carry out a control of the participants so as to gather feed-back of the race to apply necessary changes for improvement.



- Promote or advertise the activities, services, and articles which are being provided by the Port Adriano Doggie Race sponsors and collaborators.

By proceeding with the inscription process and corresponding forms, each participant explicitly authorizes the use of their requested personal details for the means above stated by DA Sports Events.

7. Responsibility.

DA Sports Events SL, organizing party of the Port Adriano Doggie Race event, is not responsible for any possible harm that may be caused to the participants and/or their pets, caused by their own negligence or recklessness. The participants declare to be in perfect physical health, as well as their pets, for the participation in the competition, and they do so under their own responsibility, exempting DA Sports Events SL from said responsibility.

8. Acceptation.

The General Rules of the Port Adriano Doggie Race may be modified by the organization at any moment, without prior warning to the participants, always looking to improve the event organization.

By enrolling in the Port Adriano Doggie Race, you fully accept the General Rules of the Competition and the Race Requirements.

9. Image Use Authorization.

Since the right to one's self-image is recognized in article 18.1 of the Constitution, and regulated by the Right to honor, personal and family intimacy and self-image 5/1982 law of the 5th of May, DA Sports Events asks for the participants consent and that of the legal guardians of minors, to publish photos and videos of the runners and mentioned minors, when they are clearly visible.

By formalizing the event's enrollment, the participants and legal guardians of minors accept that their image may appear in photographs and/or films which are taken and filmed during the activities organized by DA Sports Events during the Port Adriano Doggie Race. The images and film may appear or be used in the following:

- Port Adriano Doggie Race, Port Adriano and DA Sports Events Official Web-page.
- Port Adriano Doggie Race, Port Adriano and DA Sports Events Official Social Media Web-pages (Facebook and Instagram).
- Footage destined for public viewing.
- Photographs for magazines and publications.
- Digital presentations.



10. ***Port Adriano Doggie Race Recommendations.***

- Port Adriano Doggie Race is not a competitive race, therefore one does not need to strain themselves to complete the run. Participants can either run, jog, or walk the distance, whichever is most comfortable for the owner and pet.
- At all times, the owners must keep their dogs on a lead. We ask that, when possible, the pets be on the left side of the owner.
- Port Adriano Doggie Race is an environmentally friendly event, for that reason, and also for health and above all, civil reasons, it is COMPOLSURY to pick up after your pet before, during, and after the event.
- Once the race is finished, we recommend you wait half an hour before giving your pet water.
